### **LEARNING PHASE – TRAINEESHIPS**

### 1. Students' Study Visit, Podgorica, Montenegro, 7 March 2022

The first Students' Visit was organized in Podgorica, Montenegro. The hosting institution, University of Montenegro welcomed students in a 2-week programme on Service-related competences. University of Sarajevo, University of Novisad and University of Sarajevo School of Science and Technology attended this event, represented by 10 students each and academic staff. During the first week, students were familiarized with the new methodology of Design Based Collaborative Learning, whereas during the second week they had the chance to explore the host country and collaborate with each other in a two-day workshop, with the purpose of developing ideas and possible ways to make European Universities more customer friendly. Presentations of the business ideas were introduced in an open international event, with the participation of different stakeholders. Students had the chance of doing a Field Visit @Tehnopolis -Innovation and Entrepreneurship Center, the first part of planned capital project of Science and Technology Park in Montenegro. Experience exchange and Service Economy explained and discussed during this visit.

### 2. Students' Study Visit, Pristina, Kosovo, 20 March 2022

Universum College as partner in this project has implemented the study visit of 30 university students from Albania and Montenegro. Within the framework of the teaching curriculum, a study visit to the Innovation Centre Kosovo has been carried out. Students had the opportunity to learn more about the ecosystem of enterprise in Kosovo. Canvas Model and Mahara Platform were part of the lectures delivered to the students. The first week of the study visit consisted mainly of group work in developing business ideas, creativity and innovation, whereas the second week consisted of the study visit at the Innovation Center, as well as presentations of the business ideas developed by the students.

### 3. Students' Study Visit, Skopje, Macedonia, 04 April 2022

Ss. Cyril and Methodius University and Mother Teresa University, implemented the third study visit os students in Skopje. Students from 4 partners Universities in the region had the opportunity to learn more about persona canvas and digital skills and competences. The first

week of the study visit emphasized the importance of sustainability in companies and sustainability management in general through group work and exercises. The second week consisted on the finalization of the business ideas by each group of students, and presentation of the innovative ideas, as well as a field visit at the Innovation Hub.
